

committee. The board meets regularly on a quarterly basis. Board members, apart from playing advisory roles in the organization, are also associated with thematic areas of the organization. All programs are audited by the quarterly Board of Assessors. The board passes necessary resolution before submitting programmes and projects for approval to the donor departments/agencies. In matters of recruitment and appointments, procurement of equipments and materials and monitoring financial and programme matters the board exercises necessary control, supervision and direction for achieving optimum results.

## PROGRAMME MONITORING:

The organization conducts regular monthly meetings involving staff and volunteers. All programmatic decisions are taken in the meetings which are conducted in a participatory manner and decisions are arrived at after elaborate discussion. Reporting relationship is also maintained both upwards and downwards with regular flow of information. The board also reviews the work of the organization and gives necessary directions based on feedbacks from field offices.

#### FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT:

As far as financial management is concerned, the organization is guided by transparency in operations, and accounts are maintained in systematic manner at all levels. Monthly financial statement is prepared to monitor the financial status of each project. All the accounts (Cash book and ledgers) are maintained on daily basis. For different projects, separate books of accounts are maintained and the same are audited by an external auditor.

#### **HUMAN RESOURCE:**

Human resource is not a constraint for implementing any programme taken up by the organization. A dedicated team of personnel looks after the administration, control, accounts and other related activities of the organization. Besides this, the team of dedicated project staff including field workers, trainers, teachers and volunteers are also engaged. All are qualified and experienced to implement the projects run by the organization. Further the organization has a panel of experts whose services are engaged as and when required as per program needs. The organization follows sound HR principles for recruitment and appointment of staff. An ideal working environment is created so that the full potential of the human resource is delivered for implementation of programmes.

#### **CURRENT ROLE AND PRIORITIES:**

Lok Jagriti Sansthan plays the role of a socioeconomic development organization with the primary aim to reach out to the grass root level where deprived and disadvantaged people are identified and all possible helps are made available to make them stand on own legs and strive for better opportunities. It envisages enlarging its membership by enrolling likeminded persons with commitment towards selfless service to the society. At the grass root level it also takes in more and more dedicated volunteers with the objective to support those hapless persons and develop their leadership skills. In all the programmes the emphasis is to serve women, children and youths who have got a major role to play in the society. To provide support to the Divyangjan, Vikas Day Care Center is operating in Bhiti Development Block.

To establish village self-government by creating mutual cooperation and self-supporting organizations in the villages.



Divyang Voter Awareness Rally program was organized in the presence of SP Tiwari. Voter awareness rally was flagged off by the head of the organization Tripathi. The rally started from the center and ended at Jagriti Vikas Kendra via Hridaypur Bazar, Kachasari Patti. Organized the program for 1 week at Tehsil Headquarters, District Headquarters and other places, along with Divyangjan, other people were also made aware.

# Registration of children under Niramaya Bima Policy

Out of 45 children associated with Jagriti Vikas Kendra, so far 35 children have been registered under Nirmaya Bima Yojana, apart from this 7 people from nearby villages of Jagriti Vikas Kendra have been registered under Nirmaya Bima Yojana and how to take full benefit of the scheme. It was told that if you get treatment for your children, then you will get 2.5 lakh rupees through this scheme but you will have to get treatment in a registered hospital and not from a satchel doctor, otherwise you will not get any benefit of insurance. If you get treatment from a registered hospital, then it is necessary to bring a drug treatment form, only then you can claim, so far, year wise total has been registered under Nirmaya Bima Insurance Scheme which is as follows

Balram Singh did on the said occasion Tehsildar Bhiti Sunil Kumar told about the two schemes of the Revenue Department related to the disabled, Farmers Accident Insurance and Housing Fisheries Scheme to connect the Divyangs with the Block Education Officer Birendra Dwivedi about the schemes run by his department. In your address, the Block Education Officer, Virendra Trivedi said that the disabled people interrupted. The way India has illuminated the name of the country in the Para Olympics cannot be praised in words, after the address of all, the children of Jagriti Vikas Kendra presented a beautiful dance on many patriotic songs including Phir Bhi Dil Hai Hindustani. Gaya and painting competition was also organized, which was special, while addressing the program, Secretary District Legal Services Authority, Ambedkar Nagar, Priyanka Singh won the children Jagdish Kailash Vijay Kumar Anoop Shivani Saurabh among the children who danced and participated in the painting. While addressing the Gaya program, Priyanka said that no poor laborer of the district should be deprived of justice, everyone should get justice, the government is running schemes for the welfare of the poor without any discrimination, in case anyone is able to get the operation of the scheme. If there is any kind of problem, I am ready for it, you guys contact the Legal Services Authority, Ambedkar Nagar, I will try to solve your problems.

# CHILDREN'S VISIT TO PUBLIC AND RELIGIOUS PLACES



Children studying in Jagriti Vikas Kendra Village Pichwara Post Saya District Ambedkar Nagar were given a tour of Goshaiganj market and Mahadeva Ghat in which children were made to shop at shopping shops and their abilities were assessed which improved in shopping, daily life with refreshments and food. Efforts were made to teach the qualities of similar behavior in the program, 30 children registered in Jagriti Vikas Kendra participated in the program.

## **VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM**

Under the Ainva Nyay Panchayat of Development Block Tanda, 25 youths and 25 girls of 7 gram panchayats are being trained by the organization in the employment of youth and girls of the area in sewing embroidery, pickles and making marmalade, along with the manufacture of masks was given training. Under the protection of Sunita and Bhanmati, 10,000 masks were made and sold with the help of village panchayats. Where as 25 youth were given 10 days brick manufacturing training at Muskan brick kiln Ainwa. In which they got employment of about 4 months at the local level itself.

# **WOMEN EMPOWERMENT AWARENESS PROGRAM**



In the development block Katehri, 3268 women associated with 20 women unions formed in the year 2007 to 2008 have been given social security schemes run by the Government of India and the Government of Uttar Pradesh, especially Janani Suraksha Yojana, Maternity Benefit Scheme, Ujjwala Yojana, Old Age Pension, Divyang Pension under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana With Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao, increase the skills of women, as well as make efforts to sensitize.

The Nari Sangh on achieving the standards of facilities being provided by the government under the Domestic Violence Act 2005 and the regularization of Gram Sabha and Public Distribution System doing it with the help of the servants.

# **Family Welfare**

The institution is providing information about the facilities being provided by the Health Department in the village by the government in which the referral services being provided for malnourished children with corona virus, vaccination of pregnant women and children, small family, woman on 2 children under happy family And also detailed information was provided by local and Neelam Pandey on male sterilization and benefits. This camp was organized at Ambedkar Community Development Center Katehari.

# LITERACY AND EDUCATION PROGRAM

The education of rural children should not be affected during the holidays in schools at the time of corona virus lockdown. For this, with the help of 10 volunteers, children's education centers were operated at 12 places by the institution. Pens, pencils, copies and dry fruits were distributed to these children with local support so that the immunity of the children is good. A total of 166 children were connected to Child Education Centers from these centers operated by the institution.

# HEALTH CAMPAIGN PROGRAM- MENTAL RETARDATION, CEREBRAL PALSY AUTISM, MULTI DISABILITY

Health awareness camp for the health of people with autism, cerebral palsy and mental retardation was organized by the organization on 16 February 2022 at the block headquarters Bhiti in which a total of 37 people participated. Giving information on the health of the mentally retarded in the program, Dr. Vinod Kumar said that due to the lack of oxygen for one hour at the time of the birth of the child, the child becomes a victim of lifelong mental retardation and the mental capacity is 6 to 10 years behind the similar children10 year old child has the same mental development as a 4 year old child. Autism is a congenital disability. But the mental development of these children is similar to that of children. But this child is very fond of solitude and these children have no relation with anyone. Due to which they are considered insane, if these children get special education, then the life of such a child can go ahead, so medicine should not be taken on the advice of any doctor, so that the full development of the children can be done. Cerebral palsy also comes under the category of a congenital disability. The mental abilities of these children are like normal children, these children tremble their hands and feet, if these children also get good education, they can be able to live life like children.

# **ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION PROGRAM**

In order to contribute to the environmental protection and promotion of the general public by the institution, on World Environment Day, 5 June, 2021, an environmental awareness program was organized at Janta Janardan Inter College Raghupati Mijhoda Ambedkar Nagar from 1:30 pm on behalf of the school's manager Triyugi Narayan ji. was held under the chairmanship. In which, while addressing the children, Rajesh Kumar Tripathi, the program secretary of the organization, said that in today's time, we must plant at least 2 trees to prevent the increasing air pollution, noise pollution, soil pollution, water pollution, out of which one tree is fruitful. Trees and a tree should be planted of Peepal or Banyan, so that we can also contribute in reducing the threat of pollution. While addressing the children present in the program, the Principal of the school, Manokanika Dubey said that the tradition of environmental protection has been in our country since thousands of years ago, it is mentioned in Padma Purana that 100 is equal to sons and planting Peepal tree means 100 boys. The virtue obtained by giving birth is more complete than by planting a tree. Therefore, we all must do tree plantation, the program ends. Senior journalist of the school, Navbharat Times, Ayodhya's Bureau Chief Triyugi Narayan Tiwari praised the environmental protection program being carried out by the organization and all the children were also called upon to plant two trees. Later, 10 Peepal, 5 Banyan, 2 Pakad, 2 Gular and 2 Jackfruit trees were planted in the forest located behind the school and 4 Ashok trees were planted in the school premises.

# **GENDER EQUALITY AND JUSTICE PROGRAM**

In order to eradicate gender inequality prevailing in the society, the organization organized gender equality awareness meetings with women union members in 5 gram panchayats Chakkodar, Pratapipur, Bhagwan Patti, Tiwaripur Sabna, Baijpur and Rasalpara of Katehri development block in the month of December and January. Underlining the impact of gender discrimination on the development of women by Lilavati Senior Social Worker on Gender Equality, she said that the biggest obstacle in the development of women is the patriarchal family where all the tasks assigned to women are related to household. Due to which no income is possible, whereas men have all the outside work, as a result, the economic condition of women is weakened because there is no question of poor and weak people in our society, domestic violence by the organization to get out of this agony 2005 A Gender Equality effort is being made by the organization for the development of women, we should accept the information being given to you by the organization and we should come forward to remove these social evils from our family Women were sensitized by Arti Tripathi.

# **RURAL AGRICULTURE PROGRAM**

The organization is doing experiments in agriculture for the economic up-gradation of 25 women farmers of 5 villages of its working area. With the technical support of Krishi Vigyan Kendra Pati Ambedkar Nagar, paddy was cultivated by 25 women farmers in a total of 1 hectare by Shree method. Women produced four times as much. Due to which an attempt was made to send a message in the area that if the laborer cultivates paddy in his little land by the method of Shree, then he can get the grain of the year in his own land, due to which this technology was discussed in the area.

# HANDICRAFT TRAINING PROGRAM

Those who are doing this work well, due to which they are being able to meet their expenses.

## **HUMAN RIGHTS PROGRAM**

World Human Rights Day was organized by the organization on 10 December 2021 in the presence of 650 children of Ashok Inter College Memorial Jivdharpur Ambedkar Nagar.

Expressing the resolve to further strengthen human rights, welfare and justice for the deprived sections, program coordinator Rajesh Kumar Tripathi said that the central government has given high priority to the welfare and development of the weaker sections of the society. The rights of such weaker sections can be protected only when they are not only aware of their rights but solutions also reach them. He also said that the role of local panchayats is very important in promotion and protection of human rights. That's why work has been done to empower them. To protect which human rights are mentioned in the Indian Constitution, which are also our moral rights. We all have the right to know and protect our human rights without any discrimination, the people of the whole world the seminar was concluded with the vote of thanks by the manager of the school, Dr. Ashok Kumar Gupta.

## **CLEAN INDIA CAMPAIGN**

In order to contribute to the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan run by the Government of India, the organization has supported the people associated with community organization in 8 gram panchayats of Tanda, Karampur Basawa, Mahuari, Ausanpur Ainwa, Naipura, Maheshpur, Salarpur and Kajipur gram panchayats. Swachh Bharat Abhiyan was conducted from 15 June 2028 to 30 June 2020. In which, in the village-wise meeting, people were appealed to contribute 30 minutes for personal cleanliness, cleanliness of the house, cleanliness in public places, cleaning their drains, 7 Gram Sabha cleanliness message to make a clean village beautiful village.

## COVID-19 PROGRAM



To prevent the epidemic of Kovid-19 in the country, 10000 months were distributed by the organization in 33 gram panchayats of the work area with local cooperation and efforts were made by the organization with the help of volunteers to bring awareness about following the protocol. In order to ensure the talent of everyone in the corona virus, special efforts were also made by the organization in registering people for vaccination so that it is possible to vaccinate all the people.

# **TOBACCO CONTROL PROGRAM**

About 50% people are involved in eating and drinking tobacco in the program of the organization 500 posters developed by the State Tobacco Control Board for awareness on diseases caused by tobacco consumption like asthma, cough, cancer, impotence, problems in the digestive system, vision loss etc. A population of about 50000 was advised to make tobacco-containing families by planting it in the area.
