ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORT **2023-2024**

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:-

The AGM of the society was held on 20.06.2024 all the members of the society attended the meeting. After welcoming all the members, working and guests the General Secretary of the organization requested the president to take the chair so that the meeting may be started.

After occupying the chair by President and General Secretary, addressed the members that, during the year ending on 31st March 2024. The organization has carried out several activities. After that the copy of audited accounts were distributed among the members showing the Receipt & Payment during the referred period of Rs. 22,29,216.95/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakh Twenty Nine Thousand Two Hundred Sixteen and Ninety Five Paise only).

The President further emphasized upon the significant achievements during the period and talked about the further plans of the society. The achievements of the society during the period under consideration were in form of successful implementation and handling of the programs as below:

CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME


Training and workshops on capacity development are conducted every year by the organization. Capacity-building is defined as the process of developing and strengthening the skills, instincts, abilities, processes and resources that organizations and communities need to survive, adapt, and thrive in a fast-changing world. Training and workshops on capacity development are conducted every year by the organization. A capacity-building strategy facilitates individuals to take charge of their learning, identify their needs and priorities, and create a strategic plan to address them, resulting in organizational stability

CLEAN INDIA CAMPAIGN PROGRAMME

An awareness generation camp was organized by the society to raise awareness about the matters concerning environment, pollution, fundamental rights, road safety measures consumers rights, career options available etc. The camp prevailed for two days and the experts provided necessary guidance to those seeking them. Women welfare generation programme aimed at making women aware about their fundamental rights was organized by the society at Ambedkar Nagar (U.P.). The programme was attended by people from all walks of the life and it was felt by the attendant that this kind of programme is very useful in the society like ours where women awareness about their fundamental rights is very low. Departments for welfare of the women either it is in education employment or technical guidance etc.

CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAMME

To make the consumer aware about the precaution that they should take before buying anything from the market. A consumer awareness camp was organized by the society on the occasion of consumer day at District- Ambedkar Nagar (U.P.). The Programme was highly successful in imparting the basic rules governing the consumer interest. Further they were informed about the various consumer associations that can be approached in case of need for guidance and support. This programme has been held in October to November. Also in this programme peoples were made aware of the rights available under the consumer protection act 1986. The programme was highly appreciated by the attendants of the programme. It is generally found that the companies offer the consumers despite of paying competitive prices low quality products. Though the products are packed in very attractive packages but their quality happens to be very low. This way consumer gets cheated every day by the producer and sellers.


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FAMILY WELFARE PROGRAMME

Considering very high level of reluctance on part of the villagers to adopt the family planning methods the population explosion has taken place causing deterioration in the available resources like food, education, housing, employment, opportunities etc. A camp was organized by this society at District- Ambedkar Nagar (Uttar Pradesh) to raise awareness about the bad effects of the disproportionate growth in the population. Help of audio-visual techniques was taken to make the presentation more effective. At the end of the camp condoms and contraceptive pills were distributed among the villagers.

The villagers were encouraged to adapt the notion of only one child per couple. Further it is observed that many couples in anticipation of one male child give birth to a number of girl children. An attempt was made to teach them the reality of the modern era that virtually there is no difference between the male and female child. Both boys and girls are equal in the sense that the girls have the same opportunities as do have the boys. The participants highly appreciated this educational program. In this reproduction & child health programme, free medicine & vaccination of polio, corona vaccination, tetanus and diphtheria were given. This medicine and vaccination not only make child immunity strong but also profited them lot.

With the help of my society's members and doctors details about the health and family welfare at rural and urban areas of District – Ambedkar Nagar (Uttar Pradesh) were informed. The doctors told that population stabilization is important for sustainable development. This requires that family planning and reproductive health care must be accessible to all. It also means increasing outreach of primary and secondary education, extending basic amenities including sanitation, safe drinking water, housing and providing transport & communication. To make these meaningful it is crucial that women's are empowered, have equal opportunities and can assert their rights in all spheres – health and reproductive health, nutrition, education, employment etc.

GANDHI JAYANTI CELEBRATION PROGRAMME

To remind the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi and to arouse the feelings of patriotism the society organized various programmes on the occasions of birth celebration of Mahatma Gandhi in District-Ambedkar Nagar (U.P.). The programme was a major success. On this occasion national anthem was sung and the remember of Mahatma Gandhi with the full honour.

At the end of the programme a cultural programme comprising of dance and singing competition and a debate on "Article 51 of Constitution" was arranged by the society. The students of the society participated in the programme and at the end of the programme the prizes were distributed among the winners of the contests.

GENDER EQUALITY & JUSTICE PROGRAMME

The institution aims to advance the human rights of women and men equally and take into account their specific experiences and needs. It is considered that women's political empowerment is important to ensure that decisions are credible and legitimate. The Constitution stated that the fundamental right to equality guaranteed under Article 14 of the Constitution is manifested under equality of status. Gender equality, gender equality and gender justice are intrinsically linked values in the guarantee of equality under Article 14. The event organized by the society explained that gender equality is strongly linked to women's rights, and often requires policy changes. Globally, achieving gender equality also requires ending harmful practices against women and girls; including sex trafficking, femicide, wartime sexual violence, and the gender pay gap and other oppression strategies.

HANDICRAFT TRAINING PROGRAMME

One of the important activities of the society has been the promotion of handicrafts. Handicrafts provide livelihood to a large number of people across the country. Particularly the people who are low educated but have good skills to create beautiful things using their imaginary capacity need to be encouraged to come forward. This can be done if; carrying out such activities result in some economical benefits to these artistes. This economic benefit is what the society is extending to the


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artisans. The society provides raw materials to these artisans and gets the handicraft products ready and then sells them in the market using its own network and marketing system the artisans are benefited out of the sales proceeds of the products.

When this equipment is made to be disturb by cutting trees or reduction in forest area, the mankind always has paid heavy losses. Hence it is the matter of great concern because lack of forest for brought many difficulties to the human being like draught floods, earthquake & depletion in ozone layer too. Also deforestation has resulted into the elapse of many precious species of animals around the world.

There for society has decided to plant at least five hundreds trees every year & hence for this our society, with the help of Volunteers, has planted many trees across the Distt.- Ambedkar Nagar & helped the govt. scheme.

Also use of polythene & plastic caused untimely & painful death of thousand of animals. Our society helped out of aware the people the ill effects of the use of polythene that have now become the part & parcel of the everyday life.

LABOUR DAY CELEBRATION PROGRAMME

An awareness generation programme was organized by the society to raise awareness about the welfare of child labour in Ambedkar Nagar. The term "child labour" is often defined as work that deprives children of their childhood, their potential and their dignity, and that is harmful to physical and mental development. It refers to work that: is mentally, physically, socially or morally dangerous and harmful to children. Based on the recommendations of Gurupadaswamy Committee, the Child Labour (Prohibition & Regulation) Act was enacted in 1986. As per the Act, employment of children was prohibited in certain specified hazardous occupations and processes and regulates the working conditions in others. The guest faculty had been said that Children are trafficked for many reasons, including forced labour, prostitution and recruitment as child labours and beggars. Debt bondage is forced labour, where work is exchanged to pay off loans that people cannot pay off with money or goods. Poverty, unemployment, lack of good schools and development of the informal economy are considered important reasons for child labour.

LITERACY & EDUCATION PROGRAMME

The society has regularly been conducting children educational programmes aimed towards the benefit of the masses and more particularly the people below the poverty line. The programmes have got recognition and appreciation from both the society and the authorities. The society has resolved to work for literacy programme under theme "Literacy for all". Under this programme, women's, laborers, small traders, and poor population from slum area were motivated for literacy. About 57 people were motivated and provided basic education. In field of moral education, the society has organized programmes in association with the schools of the District- Ambedkar Nagar (Uttar Pradesh) to uphold the moral of the school going children and has regularly been organizing programmes aimed at increasing awareness and respect for the inherent Indian culture and traditions. The effects of the programmes have been enormous in terms of improvement in the moral values of the school children covered in the project.

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SAVE DAUGHTER, TEACH DAUGHTER PROGRAMME


For contributing in the improvement of sex ratio the society create awareness regarding the prevention of pre-conception and pre-natal sex determination (PC & PNDT Act) since last several years.

The awareness programme had been organized by society in Ambedkar Nagar on the brief history of the inception of PNDT provision ACT 1994 and the importance of the act. While addressing the program, the famous gynecologist said that the before this Act, USG machines were being abused and it became a booming business in the market as there was rapid growth in cases of sex selection of unborn children where preference was given to the male child, eventually leading to female feticide and alteration of the nation's sex ratio.

To end all these malpractices the PNDT Act 1994, came into being and thereby included the following provisions-prohibition of sex selection, before or after conception, for detecting genetic abnormalities or metabolic disorders or chromosomal abnormalities or certain congenital malformations or sex-linked disorders and for the prevention of their misuse for sex determination leading to female feticide. She also spoke on teenage pregnancy and cancer of the cervix which is one of the major issues pertaining to women's health.

SURVEY OF DISABILITY CHILD PROGRAMME

The society has been regularly involved in helping the disabled persons by providing them necessary support both financially and morally. Effective steps are being taken to rehabilitate and make the disabled self-reliant. Some of these disabled persons are attending the typing and tailoring programme also free of cost. This is a noble step taken by the society and appreciated by everyone. The society has taken a number of steps including distribution of necessary equipments to the handicapped. Further it has plans to establish a special school for handicapped. Other measures taken by the society includes raising awareness about the handicapped so that they do not get separated in the society. The society organized a special sports event for disabled in which 40 disabled children participated. Prizes were distributed among the winners. Such competition helps in raising the level of self-confidence of the handicapped children.


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TOBACCO CONTROL PROGRAMME

The society has been conducting camps aimed at raising awareness about the bad effect of the alcoholism and drinking. The volunteers of the society went to the villages to raise consciousness about the effects of smoking and drinking and use of tobacco. Help of posters and banners was taken to make presentation. Apart from this the person who have given up the habit of drinking encouraged people to follow their path and the restraint that one needs to take to give up this habit. The main aim of the society for prevention of alcoholism is to create awareness among individual, the family and the society. And to provide for the whole range of community-based services for the identification, motivation, counseling, de-addiction, after care and rehabilitation of the addicts.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME

The society has always kept in mind that the vocational training is the need of our to reduce the effects of the unemployment. To achieve this goal the society has started mobile repairing training at Distt. - Ambedkar Nagar (U.P.) in rural area. During the financial year under the review 90 students were trained in mobile repairing. Many of these trainers are now self-employed. In order of trade training the society has started a training center for youths and provided training in field of knitting, tailoring & beautician. The main aim of this programme is to make the trainees so settled that they might become self-dependent and stand on their own feet. Many youth took training from this center in last year. This center is discharging its duties very effectively and earns good name and fame for the society. Many students of the society have started their own knitting and tailoring businesses. The students include both boys and girls and the trainers provide them training in the dresses, which are in fashion for the time being. Not only are these trainees encouraged to create their own designs.

Society has started the programme at its administrative office at Ambedkar Nagar (U.P.). In this training center of youths are provided training in field of knitting and tailoring. The main aim of this programme is to make the trainees so skilled that they may become self-dependent and stand on their own feet.

Last year 76 trainees took training from this center. This center is discharging its duties very effectively and earns good name and fame for the society. Many students of the society have started their own knitting and tailoring businesses.

The students include both boys and girls and the trainers provide them training in the dresses, which are in fashion for the time being. Not only are these trainees encouraged to create their own designs.

A SC/OBC plan under this scheme shall be provided which shall take care. Society has been done the main focus as following.

1. To develop leadership qualities among the women through vocational training so that women can act as focal point of dissemination of knowledge in their own area of activity.
2. To develop among the non – student rural youth such attitudes and skills as will enable them to function better as productive citizens.
3. To create new skills among rural women through which villages can become self - reliant.
4. To inspire prospective young entrepreneurs to learn modern techniques / methods in training and entrepreneurship skills.

WORLD DISABILITY DAY CELEBRATION PROGRAMME

World Disability Day, also known as International Day of Persons with Disabilities, is observed annually on 3 December. The day aims to promote awareness of disability issues, encourage people with disabilities and support their inclusion in society. A lecture, concert, or other program given as part of the program. Support organizations for disabled people Collaborated with civil society organisation, academic institutions and private sector organizations to arrange programs and activities. 
